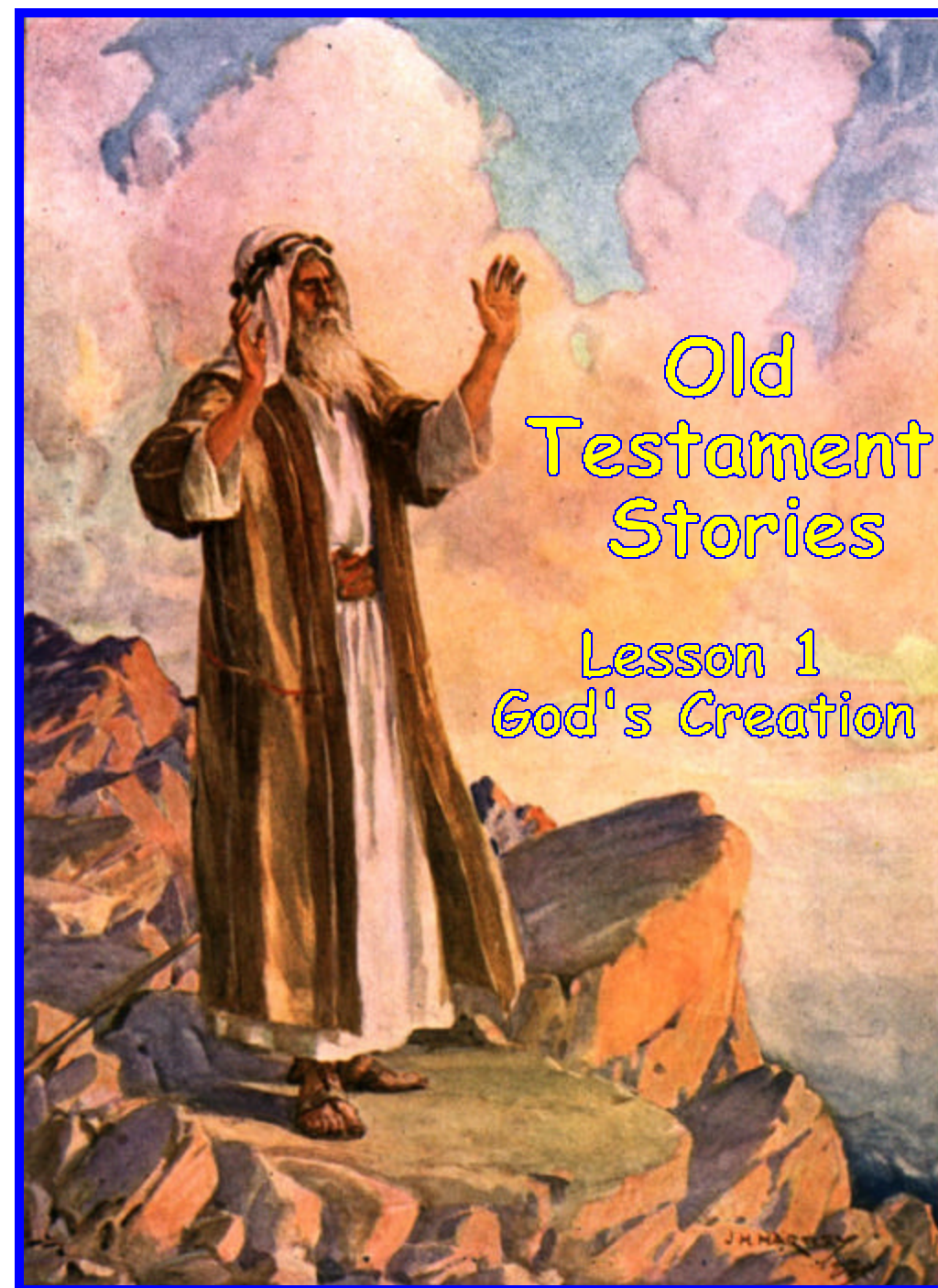
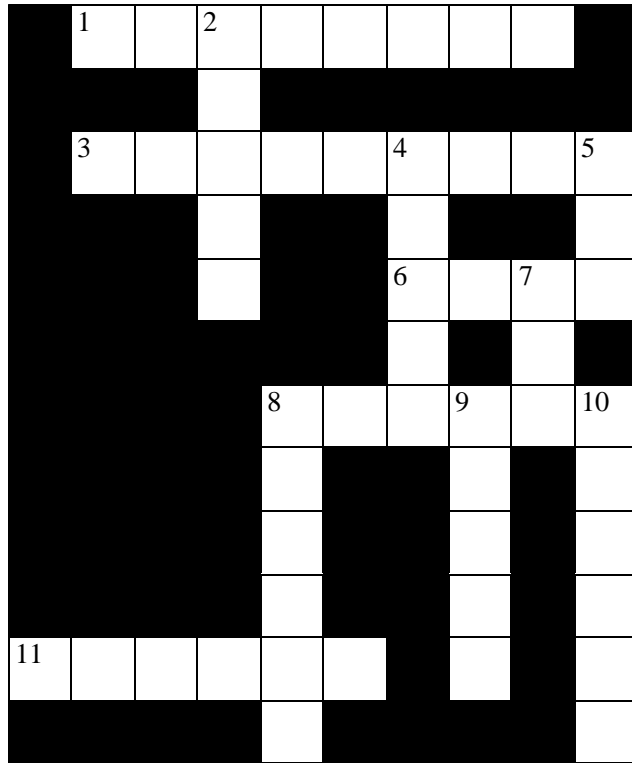

⁴These *are* the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens, ⁵And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and *there was* not a man to till the ground. ⁶But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground. ⁷And the LORD God formed man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Devotional

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

God is the alpha and the omega, God always was and always will be. Psalm 90:2 states, Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God. Have you ever wondered why God may have created the heavens and the earth and all thing. David said, in Psalm 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. Have you every walked along a beautiful scene of nature or gazed up at a starfilled sky, and just found yourself in the awe of God's infinite glory.

God's glory goes way beyond that, look at how he created so many things, especially you and me. Psalm 139:14 says, I will praise thee; for I am **fearfully** and wonderfully **made**: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. Oh the story of creation is really a story of a holy God that loves us and desires to be in fellowship with us. Rev 21:3 says, And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

To say that God created the heavens and the earth is to say that He made something out of nothing. He spoke it into being by the power of His Word. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. Just by speaking the word these

things were created. What a powerful awesome God we serve. What else can you name that God spoke into being in the creation story? . . . ? . . . ? . . . ?

How about Adam and Eve? Genesis 1:26 states, And God said, Let **us** make man in **our** image, after **our** likeness: Who is the **us**, and the **our** in this scripture? Why it's the Trinity, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit! . John 1:2-3, speaks of Jesus, The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. And Genesis 1:2, And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters, speaks of the presence of the Holy Spirit at creation. God created you and me to have a body, soul, and spirit, a three part being, just like Him, in His image.

This same God that was present at creation is present with you right now. His great love for you has never weakened, and it is His desire to know you intimately, and that you might know Him in a real and personal way. Won't you ask Him into you heart today:

Dear God, I confess to you I am a sinner. I believe in my heart Jesus died for me, was buried and rose again. Jesus come into my heart and be my Savior and Lord. Amen
